1. Johnson voted for a proposed "Dry Water Rule" which would have gutted clean water protections and failed to hold polluters accountable. MS. Senate Roll Call Vote, February 5, 2021.
2. Johnson voted against the bipartisan U.S. Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act which provided \$250 million for residential sewage system upgrades. U.S. Senate Roll Call Vote, August 10, 2021.
3. Johnson voted against the bipartisan Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2022, which included funds for Great Lakes clean-up and sewer repairs. U.S. Senate Roll Call Vote, March 10, 2022.
